

Memorandum of Understanding between EA, Eurachem, Eurolab, Euromet and CEOC

Recognizing the need to strengthen the links between accreditation, conformity assessment and metrology and to cooperate and to coordinate their actions in respect of their tasks related to the national and international infrastructure put in place to deal with these issues, EA, Eurachem, Eurolab, Euromet and CEOC have reached the following understanding.

The five organizations generally agree:

1. to strive for a harmonized policy on matters of common interest;
2. to ensure the timely exchange of information on matters of common interest;
3. to invite, if appropriate, representatives or observers to each other's general assemblies
4. to ensure mutual representation in selected committees and working groups;
5. to meet at least on an annual basis;
